If you watched the short film, Baked Fish, you know a filet of plastic can't be too tasty or good for you. Annually about 8 million metric tons of plastic are thrown into the ocean and by 2050, it's estimated that there will be more plastic in the oceans than there are fish. What can you do to help? Here are just a few ideas: reduce your use of single-use plastics; recycle properly; and make something with all those little plastic pieces so they don't end up in the ocean!

What you need:

- Piece of cardboard or cardstock
- Plastic caps, pieces, packaging
- Scissors
- Glue
- Water-based sealer
- Sticks

Directions:

- 1. Draw (or download fish illustration) a fish onto cardboard. Cut out the fish.
- 2. Assemble your plastic pieces and arrange on the fish.
- 3. Glue. Let your fish dry overnight and then apply one coat of the sealer.
