What you need:

- Lots of scrap materials and parts
- Base - wood, an old trophy, tile, cardboard box
- Scissors
- Wire or string
- Glue

Directions:

1. Assemble all your materials. Figure out which parts will work for the bug's body and head. Experiment with different pieces before you start gluing.
2. Now, how many eyes will your bug have? Antennae? Mouths? What about legs and wings? Start glueing those pieces.
3. Let your bug dry completely. Glue the bug to your base and to make sure it stays in place while drying, wrap with wire and/or string.
