What you need:

- Lots of scrap materials and parts
- Base wood, an old trophy, tile, cardboard box
- Scissors
- Wire or string
- Glue

Directions:

- 1. Assemble all your materials. Figure out which parts will work for the bug's body and head. Experiment with different pieces before you start gluing.
- 2. Now, how many eyes will your bug have? Antennae? Mouths? What about legs and wings? Start glueing those pieces.
- 3. Let your bug dry completely. Glue the bug to your base and to make sure it stays in place while drying, wrap with wire and/or string.
