HOW TO MAKE AN UNDERSEA COLLAGE

Supplies:

- Multiple colors of construction paper, scrap paper, old greeting cards or wrapping paper
- Backing cardboard or card stock
- Scissors
- Glue or glue stick

Directions:

- 1. Select the colors you want to work with to make your undersea collage. Then decide what shapes that you'd like to cut out, that mimic undersea plants, coral and animals. You can lightly draw the shapes with pencil, to guide you as you're cutting them out.
- 2. Choose the background color for your ocean scene and glue it to the backing paper or cardboard. Then, start to arrange the cut out shapes onto the background. Play around with arranging and layering them until you have a layout you like.
- 3. Use the glue stick to glue down your shapes. Do the shapes that you will layer on top of first and slowly add your layers one at a time.
