Supplies:

- Yarn in any color or colors
- Cardboard that is easy to cut
- Scissors
- Glue
- Button or googly eye
- Colored paper for wing and beak

Directions:

- 1. Draw a bird (or use the template below) on to a piece of cardboard and cut out.
- 2. Cut little slits around the bird shape, about half of an inch apart.
- 3. Starting at the tail, wrap yarn around the bird, go all the way to the head. Tie off the yarn on the back.
- 4. Cut out beak and wing with colored paper. Glue the wing, beak and eye to the front.
